Field Trip Prices:

\$20 w/ equipment (Beginner Slopes Only)

\$25 w/ equipment (All Area Access, Terrain Parks excluded)

1 FREE package for every 15th paid student!!!!



The Field Trip Program will begin Monday, January 3rd, 2011 and run through March, 2011 and is offered Monday through Friday, EXCLUDING HOLIDAYS—Jan. 17 & Feb. 21, 2011. There will be no discounts for participants bringing their own equipment.

No on-site ticket upgrades. If you sign up for the beginner package you will stay in the beginner area for the entire day. No changes or refunds—choose carefully!

Season Pass holders must pay regular price for the Field Trip program. Students are welcome to stay and ski in the areas where their snow passes are valid even after their school has left.

Snowtubing is available on **Fridays only**, from January 14th through February 25th. Hours are 10 to 4 pm.

Field Trip Coordinator:

1. Upon arrival, please leave the students on the bus! Only the Field Trip Coordinator should come to the Group Sales office to receive the tickets ordered and to make payment.
2. Return to the bus, distribute the tickets, and bring your students inside the Jack Frost Rental Shop, with their completed JFBB Release/Rental Form.
3. If you need to cancel or re-schedule for any reason please contact us immediately!

Please do not bring any outside food or beverages to JFBB.

Large Groups of 75 or more people will be required to pay a \$100 deposit upon confirmation of final numbers (approximately 1 week prior to the trip). This deposit can only be refunded if cancellation is at least 48 hours prior to the reservation date. Deposit can be transferred to another date if the date change is made at least 48 hours prior to the reservation date.

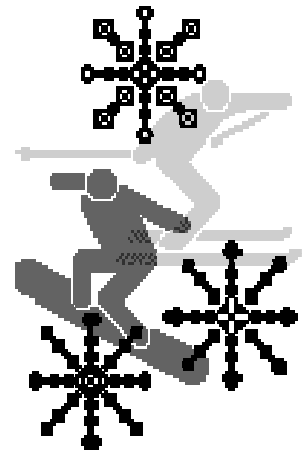
